NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2018: At the Edmonton Grads International Classic, Katherine played two games and contributed 12 points, 10 rebounds, and 9 assists.

2017: In her 4th year with the Senior Women's National team, Katherine had an excellent exhibition trip, posting the highest number of points and rebounds on the team. She had a total of 55 points and 37 rebounds in 5 games, and averaged 24.8 minutes per game. Representing Canada at the 2017 FIBA Women's AmeriCup, where she contributed significantly to help the team win a Gold Medal at the event. She posted impressive numbers averaging 20.9 minutes per game, 5.2 rebounds per game and 8.5 points per game.

2016: Member of the Rio 2016 Olympic team who placed 7th in the tournament; averaged 3.7 points per game, 12.3 minutes and 2.3 rebounds. Played two exhibition games in Spain, averaging 18.6 minutes per game. Played three exhibition games in France averaging 7.3 points, 5.0 rebounds. Played in 3 exhibition games in the Edmonton Grads International Classic, averaging 7.6 points and 14.8 minutes per game. Played 3 games in the USA Showcase tournament averaging 13.6 minutes and 3.0 points and rebounds per game.

2015: Member of the 2015 Pan American Games team that won Canada's first ever gold medal averaged 13.5 minutes and 15 points per game. Finished top ten in blocked shots for the tournament. Played in three exhibition games in Spain averaged 14.5 minutes and 5.7 points per game. Played in three exhibition games in France averaged 20 minutes and 5.7 points per game. Helped the SWNT achieve gold at the FIBA Americas, qualifying for Rio 2016 Olympics...Averaged 13 minutes and 4.3 points per game.

2014: First season on the Senior Women's National Team; was 2nd on the team with 22.8 minutes 3rd with 7.7 points, 4th with 4 rebounds and 1st with 2 assists per game in the Czech exhibition tournament. Appeared in all 7 games at FIBA Worlds shooting 53% from the field averaging 7.4 PPG and 2.7 RPG

2012: In 5 exhibition games with the Women's Development Team she averaged 19.7 minutes and 4.0 points.

2011: Helped Canada finish 5th Place at the 2011 U19 FIBA World Championship in Puerto Montt, Chile where she average 27.5 minutes, 8 points, 6 rebounds and 1.3 assists per game.

2010: Helped Canada finished 3rd place at the 2010 FIBA Americas U18 Championship in Colorado where she averaged 23.2 minutes, 7.6 points, 6 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game...Led the team in assists and steals and 3rd in rebounds in the tournament...

2019-20: In her first season with Basket Landes, Plouffe appeared in 21 games between the French league and Euroleague. She played 413 minutes.... Averaging 19.7 minutes, 5.2 rebounds and 6.9 points per game. Named the Top Canadian Playing Abroad of the Week in November.

2018-19: Plouffe averaged 24.9 minutes, 9.9 points, and 5.03 rebounds per game in 25 games for Bourges and 14 games in the Euroleague.

2017-18: In the 2017-18 season, Katherine was a French Cup Winner, French Supercup Winner and her team won the 2018 French league title. She averaged 12.9 points, 5.05 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game.
